

Tender asks for relocation to be done by the OEM, as per our understanding the OEM will carry out configuration & testing of the equipment but the physical relocation will be done by the support partner. Please confirm	The configuration, testing and re-location of disaster recovery equipment and old IFMIS servers shall only be done by OEM including the physical relocation.
3.	We would also like you to clarify if Audited Accounts are mandatory as you have not requested for them.	Audited Accounts are not mandatory
4.	Page 19, MR 12 -States that the bidder must be at-least a silver support partner, however, the Cisco silver certification was retired on April 1, 2016. Please advise on the alternative for this.	The bidder Must have advanced specialization in Advanced Enterprise Networking.
5.	Page 19, M11 -States that the bidder MUST provide proof of Original Equipment	The bidder MUST provide an Original Equipment Manufacturer
